

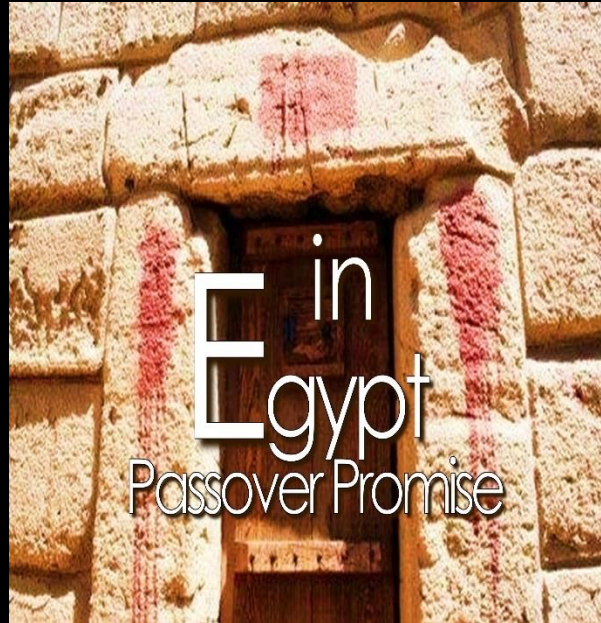

## John 1:29 (NIV) 约翰福音 1:29

<sup>29</sup> The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!”



## Mark 14:32-34 (NIV) 马可福音 14:32-34

He said to them, “The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise.”<sup>32</sup> But they did not understand what he meant and were afraid to ask him about it.



## Matthew 20:17 – 19 (NIV) 马太福音 20:17-19

<sup>17</sup> Now Jesus was going up to Jerusalem. On the way, he took the Twelve aside and said to them, <sup>18</sup> “We are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death <sup>19</sup> and will hand him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified. On the third day, he will be raised to life!”

## Matthew 26:42 (NIV) 马太福音 26:42

<sup>42</sup> He went away a second time and prayed, "My Father, if it is not possible for this cup to be taken away unless I drink it, *may your will be done.*"

- Jesus not only prayed in submission to God, he lived that way

## John 6:38 (NIV) 约翰福音 6:38

"For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me"



## Matthew 6:10 (NIV) 马太福音 6:10

"Thy kingdom come. *Thy will be done*, on earth as it is in heaven"

## 2. Drink The Cup 我父给我的杯

**John 18:7-11 (NIV) 约翰福音 18:7-11**

<sup>7</sup> Again he asked them, “Who is it you want?”  
“Jesus of Nazareth,” they said.

<sup>8</sup> Jesus answered, “I told you that I am he. If you are looking for me, then let these men go.”

<sup>9</sup> This happened so that the words he had spoken would be fulfilled: “I have not lost one of those you gave me.”<sup>[a]</sup>



<sup>10</sup> Then Simon Peter, who had a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear. (The servant's name was Malchus.)

<sup>11</sup> Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?"

## Isaiah 51:17 (NIV) 以赛亚书 51:17

17 Awake, awake! Rise up, Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the LORD the cup of his wrath, you who have drained to its dregs the goblet that makes people stagger.



## Jeremiah 25:15 – 16 (NIV) 耶利米书 25:15-16

15 This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, said to me: “Take from my hand this cup filled with the wine of my wrath and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it. 16 When they drink it, they will stagger and go mad because of the sword I will send among them.”



## Revelation 14:10 (NIV) 启示录 14:10

10 they, too, will drink the wine of God's fury, which has been poured full strength into the cup of his wrath. They will be tormented with burning sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and of the Lamb.

## John 18:11 (NIV) 约翰福音 18:11

Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?"



## Matthew 20:22 (NIV) 马太福音 20:22

<sup>22</sup> “You don’t know what you are asking,” Jesus said to them. “Can you drink the cup I am going to drink?”

“We can,” they answered.
